INTERNATIONAL WATERCOLOUR EXHIBITION ARTCITI GALLERY

The art of water-colour painting has come to us through centuries of fascinating history, originating from Eastern countries. It was not until the 18th century that water-colour media began to become popular with Western artists.

One remembers Karachi in the 1960's as a city with many locally settled talented artists. It was a young and enthusiastic group of artist including Munsur Rahi and Abdul Hayee who would spend week-ends with a group of other art enthusiasts, painting interesting buildings and landscapes around the city. They were the artists that started a Water-Colour movement in Karachi at that time.

It is interesting to note that it was not until 2012 that the International Watercolour Society was established. It expanded to include seventy countries of the world including Pakistan.

Here, an enthusiastic group of artists including the leading exponents of watercolour painting, have attended festivals, and traveled abroad where their paintings were acquired by National Museums. In 2014, Ali Abbas was the recipient of the Gold Medal award for the Biennnale held in Spain, and in 2016, foreign artists were invited to participate in the IWS Biennale held in Jamshoro.

Throughout the movement, the IWS of Pakistan has formed close ties with Artciti Gallery, Karachi. A gallery that has encouraged the watercolour movement and who are also in touch with the artists of other countries. For this reason, a fascinating exhibition has been organized by the gallery, showing the work of water-colourists from numerous countries, both East and West. We are fortunate that these artists who are well known in their own countries, send their work for us to enjoy. Glimpsing the work, it is fascinating to view the differences in the subjects and the use of the colour by the artists from different cultures and surroundings who - through their affiliation with the IWS Pakistan, have sent their work to be shown in exhibition.

Viewing the exhibition, one has the rare opportunity of viewing paintings from Turkey, UK, America, Hong Kong, Brazil, India, Serbia, Italy, Russia and Iran, as well as enjoying the work of Qudsia Nisar, Hajra Mansoor, Ali Abbas, Abdul Hayee, Akram Dost, G.N Qazi, Ghulam Hussain and A.H Rizvi. For art lovers and artists and art students, it is an opportunity not to be missed.

Scanning Worlds of Colour:

Abdul Hayee born near Agra in 1948 and completed his graduation in 1971 from the Karachi School of Arts and participated in numerous group shows in Pakistan and abroad.

Abdul Hayee, doyen of Karachi water colourists, was the initiator of "on-spot "painting in Karachi, many years ago. Hayee is one of the few water colourists who paints in the late afternoon, enjoying the deepening shadows. He was a source of encouragement to groups of younger artists and art students who assembled on holidays to paint from nature. Malir, west wharf, Karachi and its environs were painted with a loving eye to detail.

A largely self taught artist, Hayee paints for his own satisfaction, rather than for display. Though his work is popular, held by local galleries and seen frequently in group displays, his obsessions is with the vagaries of nature. A desire to capture the light and shadow he finds in fields, on water and sun dappled paths.

Akram Dost Baloch is among the founding faculty of the Fine Arts Department at University of Balochistan (Pakistan). He grew up with an in-depth knowledge of history, arts and crafts of his region and much of that background is incorporated in his work.

Akram has been working with wood for the sure pleasure of the process involved. His studio in Quetta (Pakistan) contains a variety of work in progress, paintings with decorative frames, screens containing painted panels and compositions of wood that reflect his different moods. His work is a reflection of his own personal aesthetic issues, assimilating nature with life and suggesting that all are endangered species. In 2004, Akram Baloch received the President's Pride of Performance, the highest art award in Pakistan.

Akram Dost Baloch is now a recognized name in the art circles of Pakistan and abroad for his ethnic paintings and sculpture with international appeal. His artistic sensibilities are rooted in his childhood. As a sensitive child he was aware of the distinctions and distortions found among human beings around. He grew up with in-depth knowledge of the history and arts and crafts of the area. He also took interest in the archaeological finds of Balochistan. With local motifs and bright palette he has been commenting on the social issues of Balochistan on his canvases for the past many years. Dost is a witness to the despair and grief of a people plagued by the iniquities of an unjust and divided society since his infancy. He saw people who never had experienced basic human rights. He witnessed the injustice done to religion and rule of law so that the system was made comfortable for a few who claimed to be the Sardars. As a result, the majority suffered anger and despair. Gifted with a creative sensibility Akram Dost found an outlet for his anger and despair for the oppressive system through painting. His protesting and yet aesthetic paintings, carvings and relief express the 3D of his caliber. His protesting and defiant paintings and sculptures bear a strong tinge of his soil. He has beautified his relief works with miniature like local motifs. These motifs have been picked up from Balochi embroidery, panels of woodwork, and his personal sensibilities. He also incorporates nature's blemishes in his artworks.

Akram Dost Baloch is Chairman of University of Baluchistan Quetta; recipient of Presidential Pride of Performance Award, he graduated from National College of Arts Lahore. He is a very well known painter and travels all over the world to participate in famous international shows.

Atanur is a watercolour artist with Turkish/Canadian dual nationality. He graduated from Dokuz Eylul University in Turkey, majoring in painting and sculpture.

He is best known for his portraits and figures and has a distinctive painting skill. The artist's forceful brush strokes evoke the life and particularly the tribulations of his subjects.

He has mastered the difficult medium of watercolor, utilizing contrasts in color and in depth to create striking effects. He enjoys painting people of different ethnicities, with a focus on their faces and body language and what these express.

He has participated in more than 200 exhibitions worldwide and teaches workshops around the globe. In 2004 he hosted an international exhibition entitled "Peace Through Art ", and then established the International Watercolor Society in 2012. The message of love and peace is distributed internationally through the art of watercolor.

In just 6 years, International Watercolor Society has become one of the most active art societies in the world with 90 country branches. Atanur and his team also opened IWS galleries, IWS Educational Centres, IWS Research Centres and have published an IWS International Magazine. Every year the society country branches organizes international watercolor festivals, exhibitions and workshops. Atanur travels to every country supporting each IWS activity. His goal is to make watercolor one of most popular painting technique around the world.

David Poxon was born in the Industrial heartland of England, but now makes his home in the rural countryside of Shropshire. U.K. He is an elected member of the prestigious R.I. (The Royal Institute of Painters in Watercolours) and has served on the R.I. Council. He is also a signature member of N.W.S (The National Watercolour Society of America) In 2015 David served on the jury of selection for the N.W.S. in Los Angeles.

Over the years he has won many awards and accolades for the precision and craftsmanship of his paintings. He is the author of two books on drawing techniques, and has contributed many articles to the Art Magazine press and has appeared in numerous art books world wide.

In 2018 his new 188 page book Watercolour Heart & Soul is published (ISBN 978-1-9098 13-38-0) Painting in pure watercolour medium, he uses a painstaking multi glazing technique, with sometimes up to 20 layers of transparent paint, each in turn delicately modulating the colours beneath. There is no white paint used at all in any of his works preferring instead to preserve areas of the natural paper, his paintings can take many weeks in the making.

A recurring theme in his work is the reclamation by nature of that which man has created and abandoned, finding renewed life between object and environment.

Born in 1975 GN Qazi is a distinguished Pakistani artist who paints the old architecture of Sindh which dominates its paintings. who acquired a diploma in fine arts from The Karachi School of Arts in 1995, has many solo and group exhibitions to his credit, most of the solo shows being held in Karachi.

About GN Qazi Paintings:

Qazi's distinctive style has earned him a reputation as a skilled artist. He has been exhibiting his work in various art galleries around the world. Capitalizing on the inherent beauty of old architecture His paintings tend to revolve around his hometown - Thatta and its charming facades, he conjures a world imbued with both nostalgia and peace, and attempts to preserve the remnants of our tangible heritage. Yellow dusty lanes, bazaars with vendors displaying prices and old 'havelis' with half broken wooden balconies are his favorite subjects.

The mixed media paintings that recreate the old architecture of Thatta, Hyderabad, Sukkur and Karachi are both real and yet surreal in their ambiance. Texture is created by combining various mediums and painting techniques, and both thick layers and watery drips of color are expertly combined in the works.

He has also been addressed as 'collectors' painter' by critic as his work is likely to be acquired by various art dealers and collectors in the city. color, pattern and design are Qazi's forte, and he uses these to create his memories and visions of a partly lost and slowly vanishing environment that deserves to be preserved. He brought forth the realities of life on his canvases without letting down aesthetics. Qazi deft strokes and unique way of looking at and painting urban structure, especially his imaginative use of light distinguish him amongst his peers.

GN Qazi has also done paintings other than landscapes. He also have painted human forms in a number of his works, usually as solitary figures in the architecture dominated environment created by the artist His contemporary figurative work on canvas is worth celebrating because of his unique style.

She did her shows in in Grand Palace, Paris in 1984, in Gallery Alma Mosi, Paris in 1985, in Gallery "Hans Haiden ham" Dusseldor, West Germany in 1988 and in NewYork sponsered by United Nation in 2000.

Since her very begining she is the winner of top prizes and awards in National/International exhibitions and specifically "Chughtai Award" sponsered by Pakistan National council of Arts in 1996. In year 2009 she has been awarded "Pride of Performance" by the President of Pakistan in recognition of her meritorious services towards the development of art in Pakistan. In addition to the above she has been declared "Safeer-e-Mashriq" of Pakistan.

At present she is living in Islamabad working in studio, running her own gallery and museum. Instread of confiding her talent in her own self she is busy in introducing new phases and techniques to the young generations in the spirit of promoting art in Pakistan.

It is an indisputable fact, that the authorship of the artist does not require confirmation: a measure of self-sufficiency of lbryaev is expressed in brightness of his talent, originality of perception, the charm of talent.

Working in water colors for me allows my soul to take flight above the stars. This all began in my youth. My art teacher noticed my capacities and invited me to the art studio, there I received the first professional elements and techniques in water color which have forever remained in my work. The next stage was art college where everything intensified and was more professional. During this time I also understood the secrets of oil painting. It was at the art Academy where I was trained in ceramics. This was by choice and not by accident. The technique of water color I use, which is merging of water and a pigment seen through the white color of paper gives unique cleanliness, lightness and ease. This sensation cannot be achieved in any other material as so much of it is complex, dazzling, unpredictable and interesting. That is why I have returned again to water color; It is as if you are always in movement, in search of opening something new and this process is infinite. It forces the artist to always be in a creative current putting before himself all new problems learning the beauty of the world and opening for himself infinite unexplored spaces.

He was awarded with medals, diplomas and certificates. Many of the author's works are in private collections in Russia and abroad. The main objective in the author's works is the image of light and air in his watercolor works. Watercolor technique is performed in "A LA PRIMA".

Akram Dost Baloch is among the founding faculty of the Fine Arts Department at University of Balochistan (Pakistan). He grew up with an in-depth knowledge of history, arts and crafts of his region and much of that background is incorporated in his work.

Akram has been working with wood for the sure pleasure of the process involved. His studio in Quetta (Pakistan) contains a variety of work in progress, paintings with decorative frames, screens containing painted panels and compositions of wood that reflect his different moods. His work is a reflection of his own personal aesthetic issues, assimilating nature with life and suggesting that all are endangered species. In 2004, Akram Baloch received the President's Pride of Performance, the highest art award in Pakistan.

Akram Dost Baloch is now a recognized name in the art circles of Pakistan and abroad for his ethnic paintings and sculpture with international appeal. His artistic sensibilities are rooted in his childhood. As a sensitive child he was aware of the distinctions and distortions found among human beings around. He grew up with in-depth knowledge of the history and arts and crafts of the area. He also took interest in the archaeological finds of Balochistan. With local motifs and bright palette he has been commenting on the social issues of Balochistan on his canvases for the past many years. Dost is a witness to the despair and grief of a people plagued by the iniquities of an unjust and divided society since his infancy. He saw people who never had experienced basic human rights. He witnessed the injustice done to religion and rule of law so that the system was made comfortable for a few who claimed to be the Sardars. As a result, the majority suffered anger and despair. Gifted with a creative sensibility Akram Dost found an outlet for his anger and despair for the oppressive system through painting. His protesting and yet aesthetic paintings, carvings and relief express the 3D of his caliber. His protesting and defiant paintings and sculptures bear a strong tinge of his soil. He has beautified his relief works with miniature like local motifs. These motifs have been picked up from Balochi embroidery, panels of woodwork, and his personal sensibilities. He also incorporates nature's blemishes in his artworks.

Akram Dost Baloch is Chairman of University of Baluchistan Quetta; recipient of Presidential Pride of Performance Award, he graduated from National College of Arts Lahore. He is a very well known painter and travels all over the world to participate in famous international shows.

My name's Pasqualino Fracasso.

I started watercolor in 2004. My passion for drawing and painting is something that I had inside of me as a child, but discovered only a short time ago!

It all started a little by chance but then, like a thunderbolt, became an overwhelming passion! I have cultivated this passion as a self-taught artist because there was no one near me that I could be inspired by in this technique and in this path.

So I studied books, I tried and tried and never gave up seeing that I had really begun to "think of watercolor." Then I had the good fortune to meet Franco Grobberio who made me take the next leap and from there I started to work in a more methodical way to refine my technique. I then began to make the first solo where I really understood that people liked my paintings (to the point of paying to have one in the house! Amazing!) And I was able to communicate something through my art: painted to pull out something to me, and that something was able to excite others as it excited me. At this point my studies widened, leading me to experience many types of techniques, colors, subjects and visions! Fantastic!

At the technical level the watercolor technique, as you can imagine, is difficult! First: "the watercolor does not forgive!" you can't just make a mistake as you can not go to erase or cover up the mistake (or at least not always). Second, "watercolor is anti-instinctive" I can not do with a light white: I have to leave the paper "not colored". I have to plan my work deciding stages, tones and so on, and have to have a clear idea of how to structure the work and then I can let go of the instinct. Watercolor is made of successive layers of colors so I can not just paint what I want: I think as a superposition of elements and colors that don't show results immediately. And then there are so many other reasons, however, in order to "watercolor" (and not paint with watercolors) you have to "think" differently than painting in general: once that happens I am able to make this leap that opens up a world, fascinating and painful that puts us to a new level where you can really begin to work.
