

Artist's Statement

As time progresses, I find myself pleasantly drifting towards a more siplfied way of expressing my subjects while painting. I believe that sustaining the spirit of concept of an artwork is crucial which obligates avoidance of nonessential add-ons. Focus therefore remains to achieve the atmosphere and essence of a painting with a minimalistic application. As a consequence, the artwork acquires a certain lightness which is easy on the eyes, while conveying the vital message.

My paintings are like meticulous documentation of the sun's movement by day as reflections alter colors endlessly. It is the variation of light that imparts dynamics to the color unleashing numerous hues and shades. Under such dynamics of light, working with living elements of women, pigeons and flora challenges the artist to capture the fleeting moments effectively.

The elements of women and pigeons that I compose on the canvas are primarily for the purpose of imparting movement to the canvas and to enhance the grandeur of the female. I believe that the fluttering of the fragile pigeons emulates the fiery spirit of the apparently serene females. To further bind these basic elements with nature, I resort to adding flowers and vegetation in certain paintings.

Unbroken Promises

Concocting exotic color cocktails to produce unconventional compositions on canvas is every painter's dream. A brief flashback of the then 'offbeat' works of the Impressionist and post-impressionist painters explains it all. At the time these artists were considered prohibitively unusual, eccentric and unacceptable. It was their bold bohemian conduct, regardless of harsh criticism, that led them to produce exceptional artwork that today, stands on the highest pedestal of reverence.

Thriving on the art scene of today is one such artist, Iqbal Durrani, who stops at nothing when it comes to extraordinary painting and pigment recipes. Daringly, he shows no compunction to add swagger to his mixing skills on the palette to blend paints that produce striking hues. The artist strongly believes that the prevalence of light on paints is what triggers their luminance from miniscule reflective surfaces. The opaque and diaphanous variations hence can only be discerned if the light is solemnly reckoned — which also is the primary principle of Impressionism. Sculpting paint with a palette knife, Durrani builds layer upon layer of vivid colors, akin to Expressionism, to manifest an emotional response to his subjects, be it woman, pigeon or a plant.

The artist takes pleasure in baring his soul through candid conversations expressed in vibrant colors. Durrani therefore chooses to be outright and daring in building his canvases which yield stories that diverse audiences find agreeable to empathize with. Radiating compassion, these paintings are a product of the artist's devotion to his appetite for truth. He believes that most of his inspiration and emotion comes from what nature continues to create and recreate endlessly. Nature also teaches perseverance which is a vital component of any artist's arsenal.

Durrani has never stopped to demonstrate his intense fetish to portray the alluring assemblage of woman and the pigeon. Deploying unconventional expression, he conveys harmony between the two elements depicting spiritual freedom and enticing beauty. The artist seems to explore and reveal his own soul through these elements which reflect romantic softness and spiritual fulfilment.

The 'woman' as a subject for artwork is a universal choice for its inspirational characteristics. Both male and female artists have abundantly painted women with equal fervor and creativity. Durrani's portrayal of the sensual woman together with pigeons in graceful stride and feathery flight reflects sensitivity, grace and temptation. His paintings create an ambiance of tranquility and splendor while representing the unified beauty of the subjects.

With a strong conviction to look beyond visual perception, Durrani envisions his canvases amidst a medley of dreams and fantasies connected to his life's vicissitudes and experiences. As a consequence, the paintings begin to exude pleasurable vibes that are tangible and serene to the audience. Delicate feelings imbued within the subjects impart a satisfying impact on the viewers who soon realize how deeply they are engaged. The canvases tenderly grip the audience narrating warm emotions - sending them into pleasant reveries and the land of fantasies.


Amongst some of the characteristics, Durrani's paintings boast extraordinary textures created with skillful use of medium and tools. His paintings acquire a unique identity based on the delicately layered knife strokes woven into the generously applied paints. The rich buttery application in varying densities emphasize the contours as if rendered in 3D. Furthermore, the objectively gouged paint layers, occasionally baring streaks over the canvas, add extra feel to the surface.

Durrani believes in gender equality and embeds tacit messages on women's liberation in his artwork. He has also been protesting against taboos imposed on women by painting strong, resolved faces of Eve, ready to confront challenges. Durrani believes that the modern woman should take pride in her boldness, sensuality and gentleness. Portraying the woman's determination through her pensive gaze and sparkling eyes reflects her strong will to survive amidst an environment of gender discrimination and insecurity.

The observations of an artist are probingly profound for the purpose of discovering truth in visual experiences. Revealing the underlying mysteries and unseen actualities is a crucial segment of a painter's mission. The artist continues to harness nature's abundant beauty by way of deciphering the many obscure riddles that an ordinary eye fails to notice. However, based on emotion, Durrani reconstructs the hidden world with his bespoke visual vocabulary, and says what Paul Cezanne once said, "A work of art which did not begin in emotion is not art."
